II INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENT OF KARATE

KYOKUSHIN IKO BIAŁYSTOK 2017

10/06/2017 (Saturday)

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

1. Separate categories for those who have orange belts up to 18 years old.
2. Full contact categories will be carried on even if there are only two competitors. In this case, the fights will be conducted according to the Super Fight system. There will be no fights for the third place in categories where there is fewer than eight competitors and more than three.
3. The tournament will be carried in all age categories according to unabridged IKO regulations.
4. **A physical examination by a sports doctor is UNQUESTIONABLY REQUIRED in all age categories for underage competitors, as well as a parent's consent along with a parent's consent to participation in the sports tournament and a declaration about having a valid a physical examination by a sports doctor.**
5. A teeth protector is obligatory for people fighting in adult categories. If the competitor is fighting without the teeth protector, he is doing it on his own responsibility. In the event of a foul hit in the head, which, in judges estimation, does not result in disqualification of a hitting fighter but it causes injuries and teeth damage, which according to a doctor make it impossible to continue the fight, the fighter who received a hit may lose the fight through incapacity.
6. Application deadline is 7th of June 2017r. (Wednesday). On 8th November the Competitors register will be put on our website www.kyokushin.bialystok.pl to be verified.
7. The administrator reserves the right to change a division into age and weight categories, so it is essential to declare the exact weight of a competitor in the application form.
8. Applications are valid ONLY with an entry form in Excel attached to the announcement and available on the Administrator's website.

7. Participation:

Teams from invited dojos which cooperate with IKO Matsui, that consist of any number of competitors can participate in the tournament.

Competitors, who are allowed to take part in matches, are obliged to have:

- ⊕ **Medical certificate permitting to practice karate, issued by a sports physician.**
- ⊕ ID card with a photo and an exact date of birth.
- ⊕ IKO Membership Card
- ⊕ Clean, white karate-gi
- ⊕ Complete set of obligatory protectors required for a chosen category.
- ⊕ Adult competitors – an acceptance statement concerning regulations of the Tournament and a waiver of rights to personal image (according to an enclosed form)
- ⊕ **Under age person – a written parent's or legal guardian's consent to take part in the tournament (according to an enclosed form). A competitor without the consent is automatically excluded from a SEMI-CONTACT competition.**

A leader of each team is obliged to referee during matches and to wear a full referee's garment similar to IKO standards. Since the tournament will be carried on three mats, additional referees are welcome.

4. Competition:

The tournament will be carried in following competitions:

- ❖ kumite semi-contact, according to IKO regulations, for competitors under 18 years old
 - ❖ from 10,1 kyu or 10 kyu to 9,3 kyu or 9 kyu (The Orange Belts Tournaments)
- ❖ kumite semi-contact, according to IKO regulations, for competitors under 18 years old
 - ❖ from 8,1 kyu or 8 kyu
- ❖ kumite full-contact, according to new IKO regulations, with shin/foot protectors:
 - ❖ MALE SENIORS (over 18 years old)
 - ❖ FEMALE SENIORS (over 18 years old)
 - ❖ MALE SENIORS FIRST STEP (over 18 years old)
 - ❖ FEMALE SENIORS FIRST STEP (over 18 years old)
 - ❖ MALE SENIORS +35 (over 35 years old)

5. Participation fee:

Competitors pay 15 EUR. The payment includes a sandwich and a drink for a competitor. The participation fee should be paid in cash on the day of the tournament or earlier, by a bank transfer on an account placed in a letterhead (a competitor should have on him a bank statement confirming the transaction in the day of the tournament).

6. Rewards and team score:

For first, second and third place winners will receive a cups and diplomas. There will be no fights for the third place in categories where there is fewer than eight competitors and more than three.

Team score: 1st place – 5 points, 2nd place – 3 points, 3rd place – 1 points. Team score will be counted based on results in all categories of the tournament.

7. Application:

- a) Application forms should be sent **NO LATER** than on 7th June 2017 (Wednesday) by midnight.
- b) On 8th June, a list of competitors will be put on www.kyokushin.bialystok.pl. If anyone sees any mistake on the list, please send immediately an email to karate@kyokushin.bialystok.pl or a text message to sensei Dariusz Cymmerman on a mobile number +48 666 380 666 or sensei Michał Puczko +48 510 232 752.
- c) A lack of information about mistakes on 8th June, by midnight, will mean the list, including weights and ages of competitors, is correct.
- d) A drawing will take place on Friday, 9th June and it will be based on application forms..

- e) Before the tournament, there will be a verification of all documents (ID cards with a photo, a medical certificates, parent' consents, IKO Membership Cards), competitors' weight and whether they have obligatory sets of guards.

**COMPETITORS WHO WILL NOT HAVE CURRENT EXAMINATIONS RESULTS FROM A SPORTS DOCTOR, ARE GOING TO BE CANCELLED FROM START LIST.
In any case, a club is obliged to pay the participation fee!**

Competitors will be divided into groups according the date of birth!

The Administrator reserves a right to make changes in weight categories, please declare an exact weight

Men:

- ⊕ Juniors 16 – 17 years old (born in 2001-2000 and 1999, who in the day of the tournament are not yet 18 years old) up to 60 kg; 65 kg; 70 kg; 75 kg; 85, over 85 kg
- ⊕ Youngsters 14 - 15 years old (born in 2003-02) up to 45 kg, 50 kg, 55 kg, 60 kg, do 65 kg, over 65 kg
- ⊕ Cadets 12 - 13 years old (born in 2005-04) up to 35 kg, 40 kg, 45 kg, 55 kg, over 55 kg
- ⊕ Younger cadets 10 - 11 years old (born in 2007-06) up to 30 kg, 35 kg, 40 kg, 45 kg, over 45 kg
- ⊕ Childrens 8 – 9 years old (born in 2009-08) up to 30 kg, 35 kg, over 35 kg

Competitors from all age categories will be fighting according to world-wide IKO regulations, with a special regard to:

- All kicks on the head are allowed.
- A low kick (mawashi geri gedan) is permitted in all categories.
- Wazari will be awarded for a technique that will make an impact on an opponent and ippon for a technique that causes an incapacity of fighting for longer than 3 second.

Match duration – Younger Children and Children categories

1,5 minutes round -> 1 minute first playoff -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> 1 minute second playoff, after which a verdict must be reached.

Match duration – Cadets, Youngsters and Juniors categories

2 minutes round -> 2 minute first playoff -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> 2 minute second playoff, after which a verdict must be reached.

Match duration – Younger Children and Children categories

1,5 minutes round -> 1 minute first playoff -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> 1 minute second playoff, after which a verdict must be reached.

Match duration – Cadets, Youngsters and Juniors categories

2 minutes round -> 2 minute first playoff -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> 2 minute second playoff, after which a verdict must be reached.

FULL CONTACT – CATEGORIES AND RULES

FULL-CONTACT CATEGORIES

- ⊕ MALE SENIORS (over 18 years old) up to 70 kg, 80 kg, 90 kg, over 90 kg
- ⊕ FEMALE SENIORS (over 18 years old) up to 60 kg, over 60 kg
- ⊕ MALE SENIORS FIRST STEP (over 18 years old) competitors up to 5 kyu, who were not awarded in national tournaments (such as Polish Championships, Cup of Poland, Makroregion Championships), **a division into a weight categories after application.**
- ⊕ FEMALE SENIORS FIRST STEP (over 18 years old) competitors up to 5 kyu, who were not awarded in national tournaments (such as Polish Championships, Cup of Poland, Makroregion Championships), **a division into a weight categories after application.**
- ⊕ SENIORS +35 (over 35 years old) up to 85 kg, over 85 kg

RULES OF SENIORS AND VETERANS KUMITE COMPETITION:

The tournament will be played individually in a Cup's System. There will be no fights for the third place in categories where there is fewer than eight competitors and more than three. There will be a "Super Fight" (2 + 2 min) in categories where there are two competitors. Competitors will be fighting according to world-wide IKO regulations, including a possibility of using all kicks to the head zone.

In order to limit injuries, competitors are obliged to wear protectors as follows:

In categories Male & Female seniors - if the competitor is fighting without the teeth protector, he is doing it on his own responsibility. In the event of a foul hit in the head, which, in judges estimation, does not result in a disqualification of a hitting fighter but it causes injuries and teeth damage, which according to a doctor make it impossible to continue the fight, the fighter who received a hit may lose the fight through the incapacity.

In categories MALE & FEMALE SENIORS FIRST STEP and MALE SENIORS +35 years old – if the competitor do not have a “mouth guard”, headgear with face cage is obligatory.

Every competitor is obliged to be ready 1 minute before a match, wearing a complete set of protectors. **The administrator do not provide obligatory personal protectors.**

Match duration i

For three and more competitors:

2 minutes round -> 2 minute first playoff -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> 2 minute second playoff, after which a verdict must be reached.

For two competitors: Super Fight

2 min **I basic round** (in case of two IPPONs or two WAZARIs the fight finishes before the time and there is no second round) -> verdict -> 2 min **II basic round** -> verdict -> SCORE RESULT (a number of wins in two rounds decides, and then weight - more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> playoff 2 min after which a verdict must be reached. A break between first and second round is 30 seconds.

NOTICE: There can be a necessity to divide weight and age categories differently, after an analysis of entry forms, so please declare an exact weight of a competitors in all age categories!!!

Full-contact categories will be carried on even if there are only two competitors in a category. The fight for two players will be conducted according to Super Fight system. In case there is only one fighter in a category, categories will be combined.
